A Dutch Example: Vocational Training at Drenthe College



VET Colleges like these in the Netherlands

- Have incorporated CBVE (legal requirement since 2011)
- Competencies are integrated in Qualification Frameworks
- Well aligned with needs of companies
- Include knowledge, skills and professional attitudes
- Students are working in teams
- Gradual increase of responsibility
- Assessment of critical job tasks by certified assessors
- Teachers act as learning coaches or guides


